Access period is the time frame you would like to access the RI, e.g. your field work needs to be done in April, August or January.

Requested units is the number of days you will access the RI for your fieldwork, i.e.:

- For terrestrial stations, the days you will stay at the station;
- **For vessels, the science/working days** not the days you'll be at sea.

The Access periods will be adjusted with the RI if the proposal is granted, i.e. do not add the largest period possible to show that you'll be available anytime, add your preferred one considering your research objectives.
